Notes :

1. Prices are in pence per kWh and represent a 4% premium on our standard variable prices as at 1st March 2006. The Price Protection December 2009 rates apply from 24th April 2006 or date of registration if later until 31st December 2009.
2. For credit customers Tier 1 rate applies to the first 1,143 kWh per quarter. A quarter is equivalent to 91 days. If the period between accounts is greater or lesser than 91 days, the Tier 1 rate is allocated on a pro-rata basis. Please see our Schedule of Charges (available on request) for further details.
3. For credit customers Tier 2 applies to all consumption in the quarter from 1,144kWh up to 73,268 kWh.
4. All further consumption in the quarter or year will be charged at the Tier 3 rate.
5. Standing Order Discount is based on a maximum discount of £10 on an average annual bill at 20,500 kWh, including VAT. It is set at 5.385% of the bill up to a maximum of £2.38 per quarter (exc VAT), £2.50 (inc VAT)
6. The Standing Order discount is not fixed for the duration of the contract and may be subject to change from the current rate shown above. The discount applies currently to payment of quarterly cash or cheque bills within 10 days of the bill issue date.
7. Price Protection December 2009 is not available to Prepayment meter customers
8. VAT is shown at the current rate of 5%.
9. Subject to availability.
10. Price Protection December 2009 excludes any changes in VAT.
11. If you move house during the period of this agreement it may be transferred to your new address at the Price Protection December 2009 rates applicable to that area.
