



Schedule of gas

for non-domestic deemed contract customers

These charges and methods of payment have been set by British Gas Trading Limited in relation to the British Gas deemed contract. All gas supplied under the contract from **1st April 2012** will be charged in accordance with this schedule. These charges will also apply to non-domestic customers using Piped Propane supplied under the Scheme in Llanfyllin, Llanwrtyd Wells, Colden and Stornoway.

The charges in the table below comprise a standing charge and a unit rate for all gas supplied for non-domestic purposes and applies to all areas supplied by us.

SME – Means a single non domestic site where the annual quantity held with the Transporter is less than 732,000 kWh per year (25,000 Therms) and is not on a British Gas Business Corporate gas supply contract.

I&C Firm – Means either a single non domestic site that is part of a British Gas Business Corporate gas supply contract or a non domestic premise where the annual quantity held with the Transporter is greater than 732,000 kWh per year (25,000 Therms).

We may offer to enter into a formal contract with a customer taking a supply of gas at any site. Details of those formal contract terms and conditions are available from any of our offices or by visiting britishgas.co.uk/business/terms.

The charges relate to each site supplied under the contract. These charges and payment methods are subject to change or withdrawal by us at any time and your supply is subject to Terms and Conditions.

The charges in this schedule will apply to any customers supplied as a consequence of us receiving a direction from the Gas and Electricity Markets Authority (Ofgem) to act as the supplier of last resort for such customers.
